#### Ted Abel

Dr. Ted Abel is a lauded neuroscientist and academic leader, currently serving as professor and chair of the Department of Neuroscience and Pharmacology in the University of Iowa Roy J. and Lucille A. Carver College of Medicine and director of the Iowa Neuroscience Institute, an interdisciplinary center that focuses on the causes, treatments, and prevention of diseases that affect the brain and nervous system.

His research seeks to uncover fundamental insights that can lead to improved treatments for neurodevelopmental and psychiatric disorders. He is recognized as a pioneer in defining the molecular mechanisms of memory storage, identifying how these processes go awry in disease.

Dr. Abel is an elected member of the National Academy of Medicine (2019) and a recipient of the Packard Fellowship for Science and Engineering (2000). He has authored more than 200 scientific papers and serves on the National Advisory Mental Health Council.

He has received numerous accolades recognizing his exceptional teaching and research. Dr. Abel also actively contributes to several professional societies. His research has been supported by grants from the National Institutes of Health, the Defense Advanced Research Projects Agency of the U.S. Department of Defense, the Simons Foundation, the Department of the Army, the National Science Foundation, the Human Frontiers Science Program, the Whitehall Foundation, the Brain and Behavior Research Foundation, the Merck Foundation, and the David and Lucile Packard Foundation.




