Whether you're sitting around the dinner table or chatting with friends over the holidays, here are some amazing facts about the University of Iowa and the departments we work with:



UI welcomed it's second-largest incoming first year class in school history!

The Class of 2029 is made up of 5,561 undergraduate students with a median GPA of 3.86!

\$303,050 total scholarship funds have been awarded by the Honors

Program in 2024-25!

Our own IP department is designated as a U.S. Passport Acceptance Facility, meaning that all UI faculty, staff, students, their families, and members of the community at large can get their passports processed here.

The Pentacrest used to be called the 5-Spot because of the 5 buildings which stood here.

The Daily Iowan held a naming contest in 1929.

A dental student from Independence, IA submitted the name "Pentacrest" (5 on a hill), and it stuck.

The Office of Student Financial Aid are very pet friendly! Collectively, the staff has 24 cats, 23 dogs, 8 chickens, 8 horses, and 2 donkeys!

The first international student to receive a University of Iowa degree was John H. Rapier of Kingston, Jamaica, who was awarded the Doctor of Medicine in 1864!

34 international students received UI degrees prior to 1900.

The staff at the Stanley Museum of Art hail from 6 different countries & speak 9 different languages! Many of them are also artists themselves (painters, textile artists, printmakers, book makers, ceramicists, and papermakers)!

The Office of Admissions hosted **36,790** on-campus visitors and **10,115** virtual visitors in 2024-25.



Before digital classroom scheduling, the
University of Iowa managed General
Assignment Classrooms with the infamous
rotating "boards"! Each board had a card for
every classroom, and there were three tiers—
one for each academic session.



Nearly one-in-five first year students identify as a **first-generation student** and more than half **(52%) are lowans!**

All of the University's Rhodes Scholar recipients since 1990 have been members of the Honors Program. The current finalist, Jaden Bartlett, is also an Honors Program member.



For our 23-24 graduates, **96% graduated** with set employment, continuing education, or not actively seeking employment!

You may know that The University of Iowa was founded on February 25, 1847. Did you also know that on the same day a meteor struck the earth near Marion, IA? The sonic boom could be heard in Iowa City! A piece of that meteor is displayed on the President's desk in the Old Capitol Museum.

Since 1847, the University of Iowa Office of the Registrar has conferred 450,939 degrees! That's nearly half a million Hawkeyes making history.

The Stanley Museum of Art welcomed **50,000 visitors** and support between **150 to 200 UI courses** each year!
